

DISCERNMENT GROUP FEEDBACK

September 2021

During the 2021 Diocesan Assembly, participants worked in small discussion groups to listen and dialogue with one another around one of the Discussion Themes. The end result of each group was a set of recommendation for further discernment or action by various groups, communities, or people in the Archdiocese of Adelaide.

Recommendations were listed on posters which were hung around the room. Participants were each given five sticker-dots to place next to the recommendations they believed to be the most important. This document is a collation of the recommendations and sticker-dot counts. These recommendations will be shared and discerned further by the new Diocesan Pastoral Council, parishes, communities, agencies and offices of the Archdiocese.
